About Orijin





Why Free is NOT Free

Other companies may claim to offer "free" tablets and education, but they are hiding major costs and pulling \$\$\$ from the local community:

- **Forcing Families into Debt:** Transaction-based tablets provided by telecom companies levy a tax on incarcerated individuals and their families upwards of \$2000 per year to use their services.
- **Misaligned Incentives:** Their tablets are designed and built to maximize user fees and transactions not educational outcomes.
- **Limited Access:** Some companies offer 1 "free" tablet for every 8 learners, but the remaining 7 tablets must be purchased, which conceals the true costs and undermines educational access.
- **Low Quality:** Open-source educational content does not adequately prepare learners for success, resulting in higher recidivism rates.
- **Tax Burden:** Taxpayers bear the high costs of recidivism and continued incarceration.

Create Second Chances through Work

Releasing justice-impacted individuals back into society without adequate education and career preparation makes recidivism far more likely.

To break the cycle of incarceration, Orijin provides justice-impacted learners with a **solid education** leading to **sustainable employment**.





Drastically Reduced Recidivism in Utah


In 2018, the Utah DOC partnered with Orijin to launch in many of their facilities. By 2023:

- Approximately 3,000
 Orijin devices have been deployed to individuals seeking further education.
- Utah's recidivism rate has decreased 17% points, saving the state's taxpayers tens of millions of dollars each year.



With Orijin, learners are up to **59% less likely to recidivate** than peers who do not have access to programming. Through our partnerships with facilities, they have demonstrated:

- Improved reading comprehension by four grade levels in nine months.
- 130% increase in GED pass rates.
- 30% increase in graduation rates (juvenile facilities).
- 90% pass rate for the Amazon Web Services Cloud Practitioner Certificate.
- 95% increase in access to education and technology.
- Earned trust from employers during the hiring process through Orijin and industry certifications.



A Landmark Partnership with Massachusetts

In 2022, the Massachusetts DOC partnered with Orijin to implement statewide Day 1 access for every justice-impacted learner, becoming the first state to offer education to all incarcerated individuals:

- Today, nearly 6,000
 justice-impacted learners
 access evidence-based
 programming aligned to
 proven standards for learning
- Within the first month of deployment, education engagement increased by 39%; average monthly usage has increased about 65% year over year.
